

## Genesis 1-2; Ephesians 5:31-32

### Discussion Questions

1. What stood out to you from the message?
2. Have you found yourself feeling embarrassed by what the Bible says about sex? What was that experience like? (What was it that embarrassed you? Why? What did you do about it?)
3. How does the story our culture tells us about sex differ from the story the Bible tells us about sex?
4. What does it mean to say that sex is an icon?
5. What is an idol? Do you think that we have made sex into an idol in our culture? Why or why not?
6. What would it look like to re-enchant the vision of sex you're living by right now, given your current situation (married, single, dating, divorced, widowed, etc.)?
7. When we discover good news, the most natural thing in the world is to tell other people. Who is one person in your life you want to share this biblical vision of sex with over the next 4 weeks?
8. What questions do you have about the Bible's teaching on sexuality as we head into this series? What are you hoping to hear addressed?
