1. What stood out to you from the message?

4. Why does God say to not play around with sex outside of marriage (see Song of Songs 2:7; 3:5; 8:4; see also 1 Corinthians 6:16; Hebrews 13:4; Matthew 5:27-30)?
5. How is sex outside of the safety of a loving marriage dehumanizing?
6. What hope does Jesus offer to those of us who've had our souls ripped apart sexually?
7. What's your application from this message? In other words, what is God saying to you? What are you going to do about it?
