## Discussion Questions

1. In what ways has the universe “revealed knowledge” to you? How has this affected your view of God?
2. What do you make of Steven Weinberg’s comment that you can either believe in “a benevolent designer or a multiverse”? Which explanation do you prefer? Why?
3. Do you believe that morality is objective or that it’s always socially constructed (relative)?
4. If you believe morality is objective, where do you think that sense of right and wrong comes from?
5. Which “proof” from this message was most helpful for you —looking up (the universe), looking in (morality), or looking to Jesus? Why?
6. What do you believe is the most rational answer to this week’s question? What do you believe is the greatest challenge to the existence of God? What questions do you still have?
7. What is God saying to you? What are you going to do about it?
