- 3. Which of the reasons to trust the Bible did you find the most compelling/helpful? Why?
- 4. Does your current interaction with the Bible accurately reflect what you believe about it?
- 5. Have you ever experienced God speaking to you through His Word? What was that like?
- 6. In light of this sermon, what would you say to someone who said that trusting the Bible is holding you back from having a more adventurous, life-giving faith?
- 7. What is God saying to you? What are you going to do about it?

After spending some time discussing these things, pray for each other.
