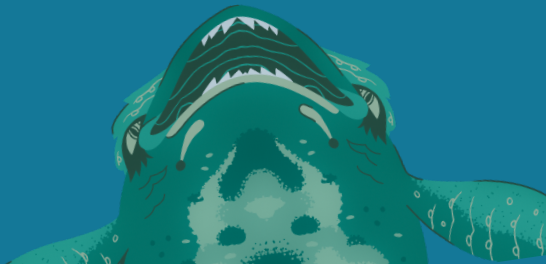


# The God Who Weeps



## Read Jonah 4 Together

## Discussion Questions

1. What stood out to you from this week's sermon?  
What did the Holy Spirit highlight to you?
2. Why was Jonah so angry after the revival in Nineveh? How did this anger affect his life?
3. Have you ever felt like Jonah did about someone? Did you find it affected you like Jonah?
4. What surprises you about God's response to Jonah?
5. God shows up with questions for Jonah (vv. 4, 9). What questions has God been asking you lately?
6. How does this chapter help you see God in a new way?
7. Pastor Chad said that the closer you are to God's tears for you, the more you will share his heart for the lost, so how is your heart for your non-Christian friends/neighbors lately? Do you find yourself weeping over them like God or angry like Jonah (or indifferent)?
8. Whose name did you write on your ping pong ball? Who is your "one"? Why did you pick them?
9. What's your plan for getting your one to church during the next 7 weeks for Explore God?
