

# A SONG FOR WAITING

## Read Psalm 40 Together

## Discussion Questions

1. What stood out to you from this week's Psalm?  
What did the Holy Spirit highlight to you?
2. What is something you're waiting for right now?
3. What is your Egypt? Where do you tend to go when God's not coming through for you like you expected?  
What did you think about David calling that "a lie"? (v. 4)
4. Do you feel more like Saul or David right now?  
Are you just kind of going through the motions in your relationship with God or are you following Jesus right now because you "delight to" (v. 8)?
5. Why is waiting on God such an important part of life?
6. Pastor Chad said waiting on God isn't passive. What would it look like for you to wait for the Lord this week?
7. How is gospel confidence (see vv. 11-12, 17) key to waiting on God? How is your gospel confidence right now? Do you feel deeply aware of how much God loves you?

After spending sometime discussing these things, pray for each other, as the Holy Spirit leads.
