2. Why is praise so important for our overall happiness?
3. What did you think of the C.S. Lewis quote from the message? Have you ever experienced praise enhancing your joy of something? What was that like?
4. What's something good from your day you can praise God for? What did you like about it?
5. In verses 10-19, the Psalmist praises God for rescuing him from trouble. When is the last time God delivered you? How can you praise him for that today?
6. Do you ever find your heart more glad in God after we sing together on Sundays? How can you incorporate this kind of praise in your life all week long?
7. Do you find it harder to stay connected to Jesus during good times or hard times? Why do you think that is?
*- How do the messages from the last 2 weeks encourage you?
What's your big takeaway?*

After spending sometime discussing these things, pray for each other, as the Holy Spirit leads.
