Discussion Questions

- 1. What stood out to you from the sermon? What did the Holy Spirit highlight to you?
- 2. Did this passage give you any new understanding about why God would say no to same sex marriage? Did it create any new questions for you?
- 3. What does this passage say about homosexuality?
- 4. What does this passage say to us all more broadly?
- 5. Pastor Chad said that idolatry makes you crave stuff that is "against nature" (leads away from life). Where can you see this at work in your life right now?

 If you're not sure, start by slowly reading the list in verses 28-32 and ask: Which of these words have been present in my life lately? Why? (i.e., What was driving me to gossip?)
- 6. How does Jesus offer us a way out from the heartwarping effects of idolatry?

After spending some time discussing these things, spend some time praying for each other.
